Dear God: Will you help me learn one new thing from the Bible today? Thank you! Amen.

1 Timothy 5:17-21







THINK

Paul talks about how people should treat widows, slaves, and elders. Essentially, we need to treat other people how Jesus would treat them. Church leaders should lead the way in this and set a Christ-like example.

APPLY

Who in your life needs extra care and love? Maybe it is a grandparent or someone at your church. Do something kind to serve them this week and remind them of the love that God has for them.

1 Timothy 6:11-16

READ





THINK

God is the one who brings us life now on earth and eternal life with Him forever. He truly is the King of kings and Lord of lords! Because of who He is and all that He has done, we must stand strong in our faith and try to be like Him more.

APPLY

Ask a parent or guardian to help you find one behavior you can start doing to be more like Jesus. Ask for their help in coming up with a plan to start this, and then follow what they say!

2 Timothy 1:6-14

READ





THINK

The Spirit of God gives all believers power, love, and self-discipline. This is true and helpful, especially when other people disagree with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Never be ashamed of your faith.

APPLY

Know that you stand in the power of God. Have you ever met someone who heard the gospel and still does not believe in Jesus? Who are they and how can you still seek to show them his love for them?

READ

Proverbs 6: 16-19





THINK

This passage makes very clear what the LORD does not approve of. To be faithful to God, these things must be avoided. Looking down on others, lying, murdering, plotting evil things, running to evil, lying, and causing fights.

APPLY

Sometimes we feel tempted to lie to our parents, teachers, and even our friends. We do this because we think it will get us out of trouble. But lying is a sin that goes against God. Have you told a lie recently you wish you hadn't?

READ

Proverbs 7: 24-27





THINK

If we surround ourselves with the wrong people, they can lead us to bad decisions resulting in sin. We need to be careful that we spend time around those who are good influences to us and our relationship with God.

APPLY

Some of the best influences can be friends made at church. Who is someone that you can befriend at church, today?

2 Timothy 2:1-10







THINK

Paul is writing about how those who are believers in Jesus live differently than those in the world who do not know Him. We are to be set apart and stand for His Kingdom's sake so that we will spend eternity with Him in glory.

APPLY

Take a moment to think about your friends. Are they pushing you closer to Jesus or pulling you away from Him? Invite a friend today to stand with you for God instead of trying to live for the world.

2 Timothy 3:10-17

READ





THINK

Believers in Jesus will encounter people who disagree with their faith. In these moments, it is important to not back down, but to stand firm, knowing that continuing to grow in your faith will give you wisdom. So keep growing!

APPLY

All Scripture is so helpful, so it is helpful that we know it. Today, work on memorizing 2 Timothy 3:16 to remind you of this truth.

2 Timothy 4:1-8

READ





THINK

People in this world resist the gospel. They don't want to turn from their sinful behaviors and just want to do what they want to do. We know as believers that we need to do what God wants us to do.

APPLY

We need to share the gospel with others! Who is another friend of yours that you need to share the gospel with? Write them a note with John 3:16 on it and give it to them.

Titus 1:10-16

READ





THINK

Paul is writing to Titus, who is a follower of Jesus. Paul is reminding him to call out others who claim to know God, but who don't live like it. The same warning is for all people. If we claim to follow Jesus, we actually need to do it!

APPLY

Ask yourself: is there anything that I am doing that goes against my faith? If there is, ask someone to help you live in a way that points other people to Jesus.

READ





THINK

Paul's message here is very clear. As followers of Jesus, we must say "yes" to being like him. With this, we must say "no" to the things of this world. Our hope is not in this passing world, but in Jesus who is the hope of our salvation.

APPLY

What do you need to say "no" to in life to help you live more like Jesus? Ask a parent or guardian to help you follow Jesus more closely today.










Proverbs 8: 14-21



THINK

READ





THINK

Titus 3:1-8







THINK

This passage emphasizes the kindness and love of God. We must be reminded that God is the one who saved us because of His great mercy. We didn't earn or deserve this salvation, but we now live with the hope of eternal life through Him!

APPLY

Take a moment today to tell someone in your family how grateful you are for the gift of salvation. Have you received it? Have they received it?

THINK

Who is an encouragement to you in your faith? Write them a thank you letter for how they have encouraged you to be more like Jesus!

Hebrews 1:1-4

READ





THINK

Jesus is the King of kings and the Lord of lords. His name is higher and greater than any other name. Jesus is responsible for the purification of sin and He is the purest reflection of God the father.

APPLY

If Jesus is the highest and greatest King above all of Heaven and Earth, we need to treat him as such. Do you believe that Jesus is the King of kings and Lord of lords? If so, what are different ways you can show Jesus the honor he deserves?












Dear God: Will you help me learn one new thing from the Bible today? Thank you! Amen.

READ





THINK

Proverbs 10: 1-5

READ





THINK

This passage is centered around the benefits of hard work. Laziness is associated with foolishness and hard work is associated with wisdom. Those who work hard are a delight to the LORD.

APPLY

Verse 4b says "diligent hands bring wealth." This is not just material wealth, but spiritual wealth as well. What is one job or chore that you can start doing around the house to grow in both discipline and wisdom?

READ

Proverbs 11: 23-28





THINK

This passage teaches us about the benefits of generosity. Those who are generous with what they have, even if it is a little, will be in God's favor. Those who are greedy lack kindness and wisdom.

APPLY

There are many things that we can be generous with. Our money to others or our church, our toys or clothes to others in need, and even our time to help others with work. What is something that you can be more generous with?

READ





THINK

READ





THINK

Jesus lived His life with the highest respect and love for God. He was rightfully declared to be a high priest by God and he was the sacrifice that allowed us to be connected to God if we believe in Him

APPLY

God is our heavenly Father and is deserving of all of our attention and respect. What are five ways you can show respect to God everyday?

READ





THINK

Living for God is useful to us. A life dedicated to Him produces fruit, but a life denying God produces thorns and thistles. God is fair and blesses those who follow him. We should be motivated by God's love and blessings.

APPLY

What are some ways that God has blessed you?

THINK

READ





THINK

God makes a second covenant with His people because humanity failed so much when it came to the first one. This covenant, places God on the hearts of His people and He promises to forgive His people of their wrongdoing.

APPLY

Do you believe in the promises that God gives us, and have you asked for him to forgive you of your sins?









PRAY

READ

Proverbs 12: 17-23





THINK

Wisdom means that we tell the truth and run away from telling lies. We are righteous when we tell others the truth and the LORD rejoices in our trustworthiness.

APPLY

It can be very easy to tell a small lie to avoid being in trouble, but telling the truth sets us apart from foolishness. Is there a teacher, friend, sibling, or parent that you have lied to that you need to tell the truth to?

READ

Proverbs 13: 16-23





THINK

As proverbs continues we gain more and more insight towards what it looks like to be either foolish or wise. Those who are wise stand up for what is right, but those who are foolish focus on themselves and their own interests.

APPLY

Verse 20 says "Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm." It is important that we seek guidance from those we consider wise. Who is someone that you think is wise that you can get to know more?

READ





THINK

Jesus is the ultimate and final sacrifice. Through his perfect life, death, and resurrection, He offers total salvation and forgiveness. The shedding of His blood was worth so much more than any other sacrifice that could be given.

APPLY

Take some time today to give thanks to Jesus for His sacrifice, and giving us a way to have a relationship with God.

THINK
