READ

Proverbs 14: 29-35





THINK

Patience is a great form of wisdom. Patience leads us to peace and helps us avoid anger and bitterness. Too many people lack patience especially in moments when they're upset with someone.

APPLY

Has your parent ever asked you to be patient about something? Have you ever gotten angry when you had to wait? Patience is a discipline that we all should grow in. How can you practice patience this week?

Proverbs 15: 1-7

READ





THINK

Our words are powerful things. We can use them to encourage others, and if we're not careful they can become hurtful and discouraging to those around us. We must be careful with what we say.

APPLY

Yesterday we talked about how patience can keep us from getting upset, but what do we do when others around us are upset? Based on this passage, how do you think we should speak to others who are angry or hurtful to us?

James 1:19-25

READ





THINK

James tells us that we are not only to hear what God's word is telling us, but that we must do everything that is written. If we are just hearing what God wants us to do but not actually doing it, then we are foolish and being disobedient.

APPLY

Whether it be to God, your parents, or your teacher, listen well and do what they tell you to do.

READ





THINK

Everyone is made in the image of God. God uses anyone He desires no matter who they are or where they are from. Just as God does not show favoritism to anyone, we are to treat people all the same with love and respect.

APPLY

Jesus always treated everyone with love no matter who they were. What are three ways you can follow Jesus' example and show unconditional love?

READ





THINK

The way we speak and our words matter. We are to be careful of what we say. As image bearers of God, the things we say reflect Him. If we truly live for God then our words should bring Him glory, not harm the way people see Him.

APPLY

Are your words and conversations bringing harm to the image of God or Glory to the image of God?

READ





THINK

God is in control of everything. As much as we always want to control what we are going to do or where we will be, we need to surrender to God's plan for our lives because it is perfect. We can trust God because He is all knowing.

APPLY

Try writing on a piece of paper "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." Use this as a reminder that God is in control and that His plan for you is so much better than anything you could ever imagine.

READ





THINK

Prayer is our way of communicating with God. Prayer is a blessing that God has given us. We are to pray in all situations. Whether it be in times of sickness, times of hurt, times of forgiveness, or times of thanksgiving, faithful prayer is powerful.

APPLY

Take some time and pray to God. Pray for your friends and family, and give him thanks for the many blessings He has given you. Whether it is in the morning, middle of the day, or night, find a time to pray everyday.

READ

Proverbs 16: 27-33





THINK

Violence and anger do not lead to righteousness or wisdom. This is why God's second commandment was to "love thy neighbor as thyself." He makes it very clear that love and patience are the qualities of success.

APPLY

Last week, we discussed practicing patience when angry with one another. Have you been practicing patience well this week? What is another way that you can practice patience next week?

READ

THINK

APPLY

READ





THINK

What are five examples that Jesus has set that you can follow every day?

READ





THINK

How we act towards and respect authority figures will really show how we act towards God who is the highest authority. Who are five people in your life, including God, that you can listen to and respect?

READ





THINK

APPLY

READ





THINK

Followers of Christ will experience some form of hardships in their life. This isn't a bad thing. As we go through trials, we get to learn how to rely on Jesus through them. It is an honor to suffer for the same things that Jesus did.

APPLY

When you go through hard things or if you are mistreated because you follow Jesus, don't feel like you have to do it alone. God will you to help you and trials make us more like Christ. Have you ever felt God's comfort during hard times?

1 Peter 5:6-11

READ





THINK

God reigns above everything and we are to submit to Him. He gives us strength and power and we are to praise Him for it. In our pursuit of God we are to stay focused on Him so that we can resist the schemes of the devil.

APPLY

Whenever you feel tempted or feel like you are falling into sin, pray to God for Him to give you the wisdom, strength, and courage to stand against sin. The devil will try to get you to disobey God, so you must stay focused on God.

READ

Proverbs 18: 10-15





THINK

Being rich in material wealth can create a false sense of security or fulfillment. People often lean on their own abilities or wealth to define their worthiness, but true worthiness is found in those who lean on God for all things.

APPLY

Pride is a result of putting your value in yourself or wealth. To avoid pride and put your value in God, you must put yourself third. This means that you value God's will first, then others', and lastly your own. Are you putting yourself third?

READ

Proverbs 19: 19-24





THINK

When we fear God, we recognize His authority and power over all things. He is all-powerful and all-knowing, and we submit to His authority and understanding. This is why it is a good thing to fear Him.

APPLY

We are not meant to be frightened by God; we are meant to be in awe of Him and His glory. Fear is often associated with evil things but not God. His goodness is displayed in each of our lives. Where do you see God's goodness in your life?

READ





THINK

The power of who Jesus was and still is gives His followers everything needed to live a life of purity and righteousness. Dedication to Christ builds qualities for us to become more like Him, allowing us to be fruitful and righteous.

APPLY

Along with the qualities listed in 2 Peter 1:5-7, what are some other qualities do you think would come with dedicating your life to living like Jesus?

2 Peter 2:1-9

READ





THINK

Because of sin in the world, there are people who will preach lies and change the words of the bible to make it appeal to them and sinful lifestyles. It is important for believers to know God's word so that we do not fall for lies of people

APPLY

What are some ways you can memorize scripture so that you may remember the truth of God's word and not fall for the lies and deception of false teachers?

READ





THINK

APPLY

God wants us to be with Him forever and ever. Do you believe in Jesus and that He will return one day? Do you believe that you will spend eternity with God?

1 John 1:5-10

READ





THINK

God is light and He is perfect. When we walk with God we walk in the light. If we walk in the way of darkness we are separated from God, because there is no sin or darkness within Him.

APPLY

1 John 1 says, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." Have you confessed your sins to God and asked for His forgiveness?

1 John 2:12-17

READ





THINK

John writes to these fellow believers to encourage them with the hope that was brought by Jesus' death and resurrection. He wanted to encourage them with the forgiveness they have received and the strength that God gives.

APPLY

While it is very important to encourage the lost people to put their faith in Jesus, it is also important to encourage fellow Christians with ways God has blessed them and for them to stay true to Him. Who can you encourage today?

READ

Proverbs 20: 11-18





THINK

We are responsible for taking charge of our faith. We can do this by seeking wisdom from those around us and actively spending time with God every day.

APPLY

Verse 11a says, "Even small children are known by their actions..." Meaning that you don't have to wait a certain age to take your faith seriously. How would you say your faith has grown since the beginning of this year?

Proverbs 21: 1-8

READ





THINK

When we achieve things through sinful actions, then we have achieved nothing. Hard and honest work that follows what God has asked of us will lead to more joy and achievement than wealth gained from lying and deceiving.

APPLY

In school, it can be tempting to cheat on tests or let others cheat off of your work. But these ideas do not align with God's teaching. It is better, to be honest and do your own work. What should you say if someone asks you to cheat on schoolwork?

READ





THINK

God loves all people. His love is unmeasurable and is so much greater than any other love we could ever experience. If we follow Him, we are children of God, but if we live for the world, we are not His Children.

APPLY

Children of God obey Him, love others, and know what is right. Those who do not know what is right and have no love for others, are not children of God. Think about who you follow and what you believe. Are you a child of God?

READ





THINK

READ

READ

READ
