## **THINK**

# **APPLY**

## **THINK**

## **THINK**

Jesus tells the Church to run away from their sins and to continue living for God. What sin do we need to run from and what is a way that we can live for God, today?

## **THINK**

## **THINK**

While we are advised to surround ourselves with good influences that doesn't mean that we are allowed to be mean to those who are bad influences. The LORD asks us to love all people regardless of how they treat us.

**APPLY** 

Is there someone in school who is being mean to you? How can you be nice to them and show them God's love this week?

Revelation 5: 7-12





## **THINK**

The Lamb is Jesus who sacrificed himself for all people so that we might be saved. Jesus didn't die for a particular group, he died to save every person across the world.

People follow Jesus all around the world. They live in different countries and speak other languages, but they all believe in him. Who is one person you know that you can tell about Jesus?

## **THINK**

As God appears to those on earth they are scared of His presence and disappointment in them. He's disappointed because of their sin and disobedience to Him. The people know they did wrong by God, so they hide from him.

When we have a relationship with God and follow His instruction we don't need to be afraid or hide from Him. What is something that God asks us to do that you can do, today?

## **THINK**

## **THINK**

Incense is associated with prayer a lot throughout the Bible. As incense is pleasing to us, prayer in the same way is pleasing to God. Incense rising symbolizes our prayers rising to God.

We continue in our relationship with God by praying to Him. God wants to hear our prayers. What are three things that you can pray for each day?

## **THINK**

People still chose to worship idols other than God despite being surrounded by the frightening presence of God's judgment. He gives them a chance to repent, but they still acknowledge statues and demons above the Him.

**APPLY** 

Sometimes we worship or acknowledge something more than God. Is there anything in your life that you are worshiping above God?

**Proverbs 26: 17-22** 





## **THINK**

Do not get involved in a fight that does not involve you. Likewise do not spread the information or others as gossip because it will only lead to more fighting.

# **APPLY**

Have you ever said something to a sibling or friend that upset them? Did you respond by saying "I'm only joking." Saying that you were joking does not fix the hurt that that person felt. Be sure to guard your words around others.

**Proverbs 27: 5-10** 





## **THINK**

This passage emphasizes the need for both family but also true friends. Friends will be with you in places that your family might not be such as school, work, and where you'll live one day. Make sure you surround yourself with Godly friends.

## **APPLY**

We should not be defensive when a family member or friend corrects us about something we did. They are speaking to us out of love and want to see us improve. Are your friends seeking God too?

Revelation 10: 8-11





## **THINK**

This passage refers to Ezekiel 1: 1-3 where he also had to eat the scroll. Eating the scroll symbolizes understanding God's word and having it in our heart before we try to speak it to others.

Reading the bible every day is important because we need to understand it so we can teach it to others. What have been your three favorite passages you've read in your quiet time this month?

## **THINK**

## **THINK**

The woman giving birth is a symbol of Jesus and his people. The dragon is a symbol of the devil and all evil. We see that the dragon wants to consume Jesus, who is meant to rule all the nations.

**APPLY** 

The devil is the biggest villain in the Bible. He hates that people love God and want to be with Him. Because of this, the devil will try to tempt you to sin. What are some ways that you can avoid the devil.

## **THINK**

The devil will do anything to deceive you and distract you from following God. The beast is one example of this. As said yesterday, he is a villain and wants you to do wrong.

## **THINK**

This passage references the "eternal gospel". This describes the gospel as unchanging and never-ending. It is constant and will never change from what it has been presented as.

# **APPLY**

There is only one way to have a relationship with God: believing in the gospel. As those who believe in God, we share the gospel with others. Do you know what the gospel is? How would you describe it in your own words?

**Proverbs 28: 13-16** 





## **THINK**

Sometimes we try to hide from God. We try to hide our sins from Him or others, hoping that they won't be exposed. But only through making ourselves and our sins known to God do we experience forgiveness and growth.

## **APPLY**

A crucial part of our relationship with God is confessing our sins to Him. You can also confess your sins to another as an accountability partner so that they can help you from sinning again. Do you have an accountability partner?

**Proverbs 29: 18-23** 





## **THINK**

Beware being associated with those who actively sin against the LORD. Even being around someone when they sin (such as stealing) can put you in a hard position of having to tell the truth or lie about his theft.

## **APPLY**

When we surround ourselves with Godly people who seek God's wisdom and instruction we make it harder for sin to have control over us. As we get ready for the new year, who is someone who loves God that you should try to befriend?

**Revelation 16: 17-21** 





## **THINK**

God's judgment towards the people of the earth, who have been living in disobedience to Him, is represented by the storms, earthquakes, and plagues. As this is happening, instead of repenting, the people curse God's name.

## **APPLY**

People sometimes blame God for the bad things that happen in their lives. In reality, the bad things that happen give us more reason to run to God for safety and reliance. What do you do when bad things happen? Do you go to God?

**Revelation 17: 8-14** 





## **THINK**

No matter the opponent, Jesus will always triumph over his enemies. He is the "King of kings" and with that has an authority like no other.

## **APPLY**

One of the many reasons that Jesus has the highest authority is because he never sinned. When people were mean to Jesus, he was only ever kind and loving to them. We can model Jesus in this way. How can you be kind to others today?

## **THINK**

The merchants of Babylon prioritized their material wealth over everything. Our relationship with God is more important than any material wealth. This Christmas how should we prioritize our relationship with God over our gifts?

## **THINK**

Having a relationship with God means we will live forever with Him in heaven. There we will celebrate and worship God together. Until then, how can we celebrate God's goodness while on earth?

## **THINK**

Jesus' victory over the devil has already been predicted. He will punish the devil forever and ever. Just as he conquered death, Jesus will conquer evil.

Earlier this month the devil was described as a villain. Now we see that he is defeated by the greatest hero ever, Jesus. Jesus is a hero because he does what is right and speaks out against what is wrong. How can you be a hero like Jesus?

## **THINK**
