

MARCH 1

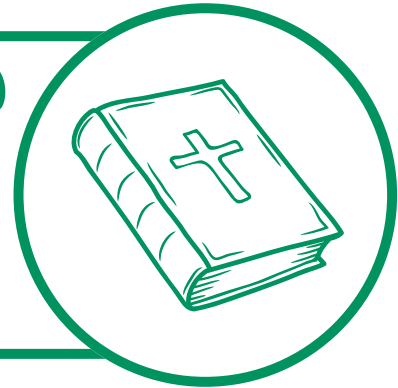


PRAY

THINK

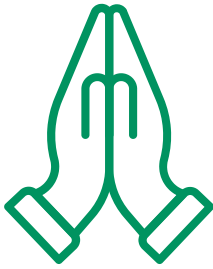
Worry and confidence can both stem from pride. Both of those mindsets put us ahead of God. Are you giving God the credit He is due?

THINK

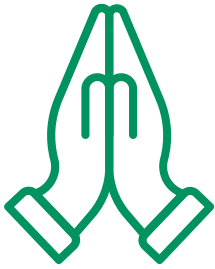
How we spend each day is important. Are you using your time wisely? Do you fill your day with good things or bad things?

MARCH 3

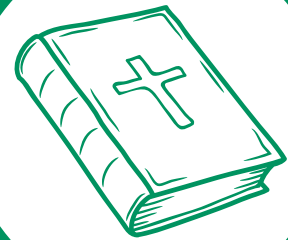


PRAY

MARCH 4

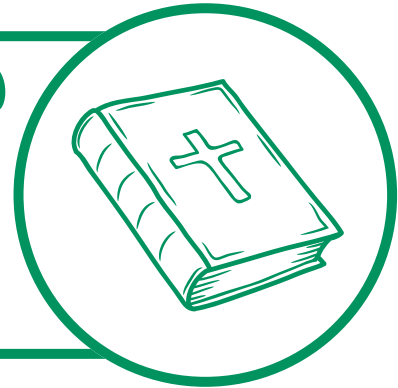


PRAY

THINK

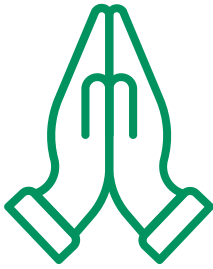

READ



THINK

We do not recommend that you run away from your parents. Jesus had earthly parents, but His mission was to do the will of His Father. During that mission He “grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man.”

APPLY

Our goal for you is that you would grow in wisdom and in favor with God and man. What does it look like to grow in wisdom? How do you do that?

Luke 3:8-17

READ



THINK

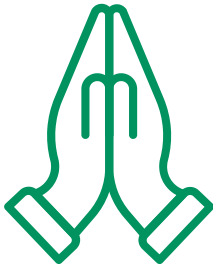
John the Baptist was doing great things. He was preaching to the people. He was guiding people on how to live a good life. He was baptizing people constantly. However, he never stopped putting the focus on how great Jesus is.

APPLY

Do you struggle with keeping the focus on you? Do you like being in the spotlight? Here's a challenge for today: Find three and ask each of them three questions about them. Be others focused!



MARCH 7

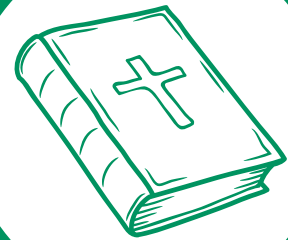


PRAY

READ



THINK

Jesus stood toe to toe with the devil. The devil tempted Jesus three times. All three times, Jesus quoted Scripture. More importantly, Jesus did not give up what His body or mind wanted in the moment because He was focused on what was more important.

APPLY

This is a good reminder for all of us to memorize: don't give up what is most important to you for something you want now. What are the top three things that are most important to you? (Family, friends, church, school, sports...)

READ

Psalm 40:1-8



THINK

God has changed your life! He has taken you out of your old life and given you a new one. How does your life look different with God in it?

APPLY

What do you think a next step in your faith would be? Take some time to think about how you can keep growing in your walk with God.



MARCH 9

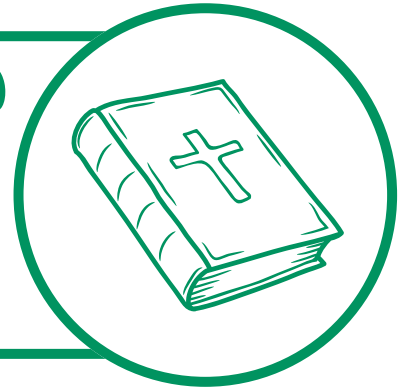


PRAY

THINK

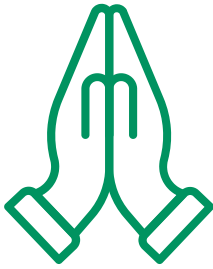
Sometimes life is easy and sometimes life is hard. Hard is not bad, hard is just hard. When life gets hard, we can still praise God!

MARCH 10

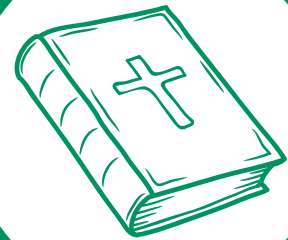


PRAY

MARCH 11

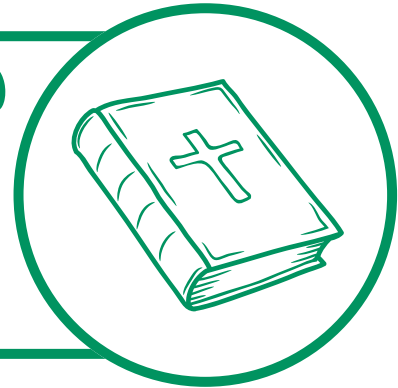


PRAY

THINK

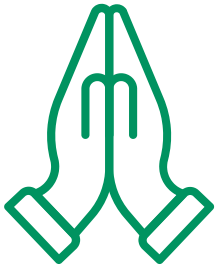

APPLY

MARCH 12

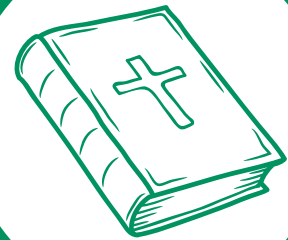


PRAY

READ



THINK

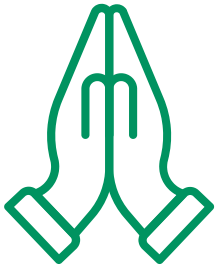
The woman that Jesus was talking about wanted to show how thankful she was for Him. So, she showed Jesus a large amount of gratitude. Why? She wanted Jesus to know how important He is to her.

APPLY

Unexpressed gratitude, communicates ingratitude. When we don't say "thank you" for something someone does for us, it shows that we don't really care. Challenge: go to everyone in your family and thank them for something they have done for you.



MARCH 13

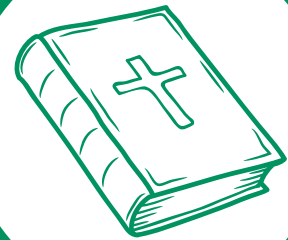


PRAY

READ



THINK

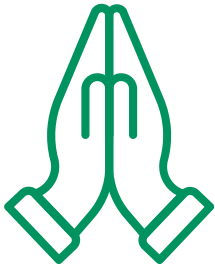
This is a small passage, but it says a lot. Jesus is telling us that His closest family are those who hear AND obey God's word. We grow closer to Jesus when we read His word and then do what it says.

APPLY

Take 5 minutes and look over your journal at the things you have been writing down from your quiet time. Have you been doing those things? This is a good reminder to do what Jesus tells us to do!



MARCH 14

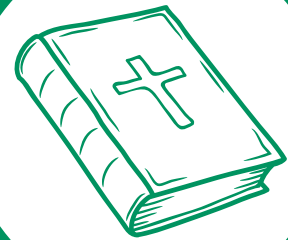


PRAY

APPLY

THINK

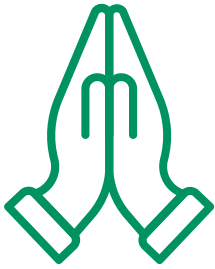
The world can be chaotic and distracting around us. When we take time to slow down, we can realize that God is with us.

THINK

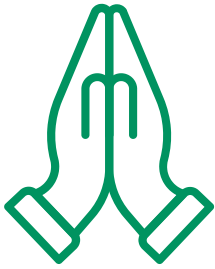
God is king over all. He is worthy of all of our praise. How can you praise God today?

MARCH 17

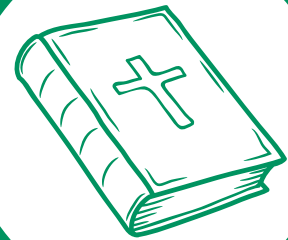


PRAY

This Samaritan did something no one expected. He served

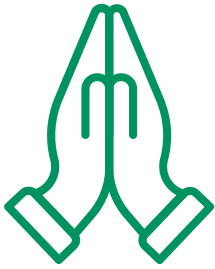
APPLY

MARCH 18

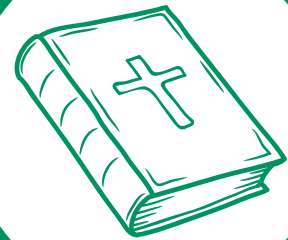


PRAY

THINK

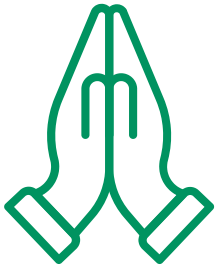

APPLY

MARCH 19

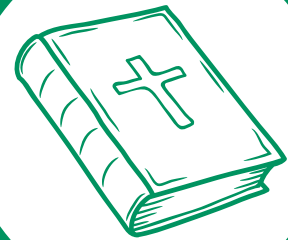


PRAY

READ



THINK

APPLY

Is there anything you have that you don't use or need anymore? A toy? A video game system? Some clothes? Think about it. Look through your stuff. If you don't need it, find someone who does and donate it. Important: Make sure your parents help you with this!

THINK

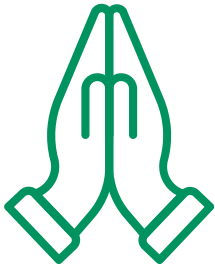

APPLY

Make a list five ways you can grow closer to God every day.

READ

Luke 14:7-14



THINK

Jesus isn't just talking about good manners here. He's talking about a lifestyle. A life that is focused on putting others before ourselves.

APPLY

In life, we all need JOY. Jesus. Others. Yourself. Remember that. Focus on Jesus first. Then, others. Then, yourself.

PRAY

READ

Psalm 50: 7-15



THINK

God doesn't need anything from us. It's all His anyways. Have you been grateful for what He has blessed you with?

APPLY

List 10 things that you are thankful for today.





MARCH 23



PRAY

READ

Psalm 51:10-17



THINK

We have all done wrong things. God offers us His forgiveness when we ask. When was the last time you confessed your sin to God.

APPLY

Write down some of the wrong things that you've done on a piece of paper. Ask God for forgiveness as you write. After you are done, rip up the paper as a sign of God giving you a clean heart.





MARCH 24

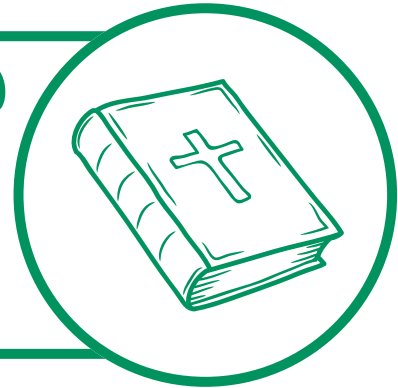


PRAY

Dear God: Will you help me learn one new thing from the Bible today? Thank you! Amen.

READ

Luke 15:4-10



THINK

Have you ever felt lost? You're going through a hard time and do not know what to do next. Being lost is hard and not fun. Jesus told them a story to show how He will always search for us. No matter what. If you're lost, He's looking for you!

APPLY

Ask your parents to borrow \$1. Or \$5. Then, have them hide it in your room. If they're willing, maybe they'll let you keep it? Somewhere really good so it will be hard to find. Now, go and find it! This is what it's like for Jesus when he's looking for His people.





MARCH 25



PRAY

Dear God: Will you help me learn one new thing from the Bible today? Thank you! Amen.

READ

Luke 16:10-15



THINK

Jesus tells us here that serving two masters is impossible. You can have lots of money and love God, but cannot serve both. It's all about our heart. How can you know which one you serve?

APPLY

Do you serve money or God? Look at how you spend your money. Follow your money to find where your heart lies.





MARCH 26



PRAY

Dear God: Will you help me learn one new thing from the Bible today? Thank you! Amen.

Luke 17:11-19

READ



THINK

Jesus did a big miracle for these ten people. He removed their leprosy, which is a disease that affects your entire body with sores. Jesus removed it all with His words. Yet, only one person praised Him for it.

APPLY

Do you take time to thank God and give Him glory for the things He does for you? Write down three big things you have seen God do for you. Take a few minutes and thank Him for those things.





MARCH 27



PRAY

Dear God: Will you help me learn one new thing from the Bible today? Thank you! Amen.

READ

Luke 18:9-14



THINK

Jesus tells us a story about two people and how they pray. One was praying to God, but focused on himself. The other was only focused on God. God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble!

APPLY

How do you pray? Do you focus on other people seeing and hearing you? Or do you pray because you want to talk to your Heavenly Father?





MARCH 28

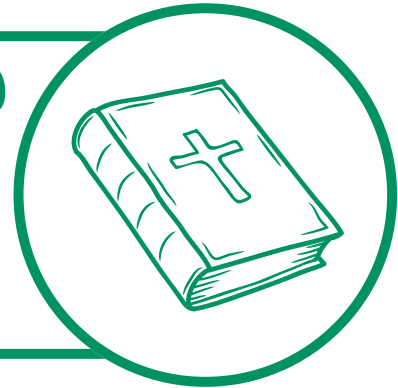


PRAY

READ

Luke 19:1-10



THINK

This is the only time the job Chief Tax Collector is mentioned. Tax collectors were liars and cheaters. So we can see here that Zacchaeus was not a very good person. However, He wanted to change. So, he tried to get close to Jesus.

APPLY

When you do something wrong, what do you do?
Or do you try to get closer to Jesus?

READ

Psalm 55:16-23



THINK

God cares about all of your problems, big and small. Do you trust in Him?

APPLY

Write down whatever problems come to your mind for 1 minute. Through prayer, give them over to God.

READ

Psalm 56:1-4



THINK

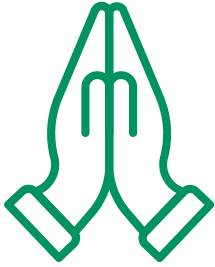
God can help you overcome any fear if you trust in Him. What is something that you are afraid of right now?

APPLY

Do you fear people's opinions of you? Remember that what truly matters is are you doing what God wants you to do, not just what people want you to do.



MARCH 31

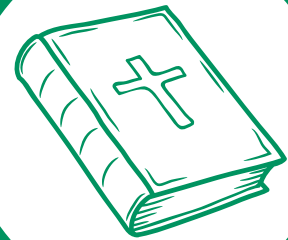


PRAY

READ

Luke 20:1-8



THINK

If the chief priests and the teachers of the law always spoke the truth, their answer would have been easy. They worried about what others would think before they answered, instead of answering truthfully.

APPLY

Sometimes we have to say hard things. Filter what you say with three questions:

1. Is it kind?
2. Is it true?
3. Is it necessary?
