READ

THINK

THINK

READ

1 Corinthians 1:18-25





THINK

In all of God's incredible power, He used something like a cross in His plan of salvation. God is so wise and it is such a gift that Jesus died on the cross and rose again.

APPLY

While using a cross doesn't seem to make perfect sense to us, God knows more than we do. We know that we can trust God no matter what. What is one area of your life that you can trust God with today?

1 Corinthians 2:1-5





THINK

Paul expresses his feelings that he is not a very good speaker. He didn't think he was wise, but weak and fearful. All of this just goes to show how the Lord works in and through His people!

APPLY

God is the one who gives us strength to do what He has called us to do. He has called us to tell people about Him! Even though you may be a little bit nervous, who can you share the gospel with today?

READ

1 Corinthians 3:5-9





THINK

As believers, we are servants of the Lord and must live for Him. Through the example of Paul and Apollo here, we know that God makes His kingdom grow.

APPLY

THINK

THINK

We need relationships with people who push us to be more like Jesus, rather than those who are trying to pull us away from him. Who can you look up to in the faith as you walk with Jesus?

READ

1 Corinthians 6:16-20





THINK

When we accept the free gift of salvation, the same Holy Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead is now with us too. Our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit because He is always with us.

APPLY

We belong to Jesus and we must honor him in all that we say and do. How can you honor God with your life today?









PRAY

READ

1 Corinthians 7:17-24





THINK

The Corinthians were in all sorts of situations in life. What we know is that no matter what our lives look like, we must prioritze believing in God and following the commands He gives us in Scripture.

APPLY

It is so important that we devote our lives to following Jesus and walking in obedience. How can you follow one of God's commands today?

It is important to create relationships with others. Who is someone in your life that you need to find common ground with in order to point them to Jesus?









READ

1 Corinthians 11:23-26





THINK

The Lord's Supper is a representation of the body and blood of Christ. This is something we often take in the setting of the local church alongside other believers.

APPLY

This is a way of proclaiming the death of Jesus until he returns again. Have you ever taken communion? What does the Lord's Supper mean to you?









PRAY

READ

1 Corinthians 12: 21-31





THINK

All believers make up the Body of Christ. No believer is any less or more important than the others- we all work together to appreciate our diversity.

APPLY

No body part is more or less important than others, just like believers belonging to Christ. Who is someone that you have been overlooking that you need to show God's kindness to?









PRAY

READ

1 Corinthians 13:1-6





THINK

This chapter is all about love. We know that love is so special because God Himself is the very representation of love! He is patient, kind, and so much more!

APPLY

THINK

Jesus has overcome sin and death forever. God has given us this very same victory in Christ! Christ has given us the strength that we need to stand firm in our faith.

APPLY

We must be sure of who Jesus is and what he has done for us. How can you remind yourself each day of the victory you have in Jesus?









PRAY

READ

1 Corinthians 16: 21-24





THINK

Paul wraps up this letter by sending the grace of the Lord and his own love to the Corinthians. He loves these people so much and wants them to know Jesus more fully.

APPLY

It is so important that we share the love and grace of Jesus. How can you demonstrate these to someone in your life today?









PRAY

READ

2 Corinthians 1:3-7





THINK

God is the God of all comfort. He sits with us in all of our troubles and helps us so that we can also help others. This helps us know the hope we have of Christ, who suffered on our behalf.

APPLY

Think of a time in your life that someone provided comfort to you in a difficult circumstance. How can you look back and see the comfort of the Lord through this situation?









PRAY

READ

2 Corinthians 2:5-11





THINK

When someone close to us wrongs us, it is important to both forgive them and reaffirm our love for them. We know that we forgive others for Christ's sake because of how he has forgiven our own sins.

APPLY

Think of a time when someone wronged you in a specific way. How did you respond? How could you have responded differently in light of the forgiveness of Jesus?
