








Dear God: Will you help me learn one new thing from the Bible today? Thank you! Amen.

The glory of the Lord is transforming us to be more like Him each and every day. What is one action step you can take today to be more like Jesus?









Memorizing verses gives us weapons against the enemy. Memorize verse 9 today.









Is there any form of media that you are spending too much time on? If so, what is it? Consider giving up screentime for the day!









Take a moment and draw the most important thing in your life. What is it? Take a moment to think: is God the most important to me? Why or why not?











Take a moment to write down a difficult situation you have encountered in life. What happened? Reflect on this to see how Jesus was right there with you.









It is so important that we do what is right in the eyes of the Lord. What is one behavior you need to stop doing today in order to be more like Jesus?









In turn, we must give ourselves to the Lord and serve Him and serve other people. What is something you can give to someone else today to practice generosity?









Memorize verse 103. What does this verse mean?












We can't see what the future holds but we know God's Word can guide us. Memorize verse 105 to help you through times of uncertainty.









We should thank God for who He is and all He has done. What is something you can do for someone else today to express how grateful you are to God?









We must stand strong in our faith and know the truth that God gives us in His word. What is one truth about God that you need to be reminded of today?









We must be bold followers of Jesus. How can you grow in boldness in your faith? Who can you share the gospel with today?









God equips us to do what He wants us to do! Is there any area of your life that you are doubting God's power? What is it?









Encouraging others in their walks with Jesus helps them stay strong in their faith. What is one verse you can share with someone today to encourage them?









Try to talk to God at least 5 separate times today.












God is always with us and ready to help. Memorize verses 1-2 to help reinforce this truth.









We must not change the way we act around other people in attempts to win their approval. Have you ever done this? How can you remind yourself that you are living to please God?









The Lord has given us much to be grateful for. Take a moment to write down three reasons why you are thankful for Jesus.









We must love others as if they were a part of our family. Is there anyone in your life that you are mistreating because they are different than you? Who is it and how can you show them the love of Christ?









God shows us how important the idea of family is. Who are some people in your family that you love? Why do you love them so much?









Take a look at verses 22-23 again. What fruit comes most naturally to you? Which one do you believe you need to grow in the most?









Invite God into every part of your day today. Before each part of your day, take some time to pray and talk to God.












Is there any one that you don't get along with right now? Who is it? Do your best to make peace with them today.









It's especially important to do good to those who are in the family of God. Think of one believer that you can do something nice for today. Go and do good!









We also need to know God more and more. What steps do you need to take today in order to know God better?









God has prepared each of us for good works. What special gifts, talents, and strengths has the Lord given you? How can you use them to further His kingdom?









God does more than all we could ever ask or imagine. Have you ever prayed to God, asking Him for something? What was it and how did He answer you?









We are all united in the family of God. How can you seek unity with someone today? Do you need to apologize to them or ask for forgiveness? Take the action step necessary.









God knows everything about you because He made you! Write down some of the gifts He has created you with.











