Woodlands Overview

- Woodlands Camp was founded in 1997 in Cleveland, GA
- Over the last 25+ years, Woodlands has grown from 150 to 10,000 campers per summer
- As a result of God's faithfulness, we've seen over 5,500 campers place their trust in Jesus for the first time at camp
- Highly sought after program by churches and campers alike
- Our day camp program allows us to take all that we've learned in 25+ years of camp ministry and share it with you and your community

Freestyle Overview

- All campers will experience impactful Bible teaching and unforgettable activities led by background-checked and highly trained Woodlands staff
- Activities include high-energy large group games, 9-square, gaga ball, inflatable obstacle course, rock climb slide, water slide, and trading post (camp store)
- Camp runs Monday- Friday from 9am-4pm
- Kids who have completed K-5th grade can register
- Minimum number of campers is 75 with a max capacity of 200, with the option of combining up to 3 teams



Why Day Camp?

- Kids spend 7-9 hours a day connected to a device
- This generation is the most biblically illiterate generation ever
- Camp is one of the few places that kids can disconnect from technology
- Day camp allows campers to have a Woodlands experience while spending the night in their own home
- Day camp allows us the opportunity to bring Woodlands to you, creating synergy between Woodlands Camp and local churches



What is a Synergy Site?


Synergy: Two or more forces working together in a particularly fruitful way that produces an outcome greater than the sum of their individual efforts

Why is Synergy Important?

Our combined efforts help us reach maximized potential in key areas:

What a Synergy Site provides:

- Facilities, grounds, and support
- A point person between Woodlands and the Synergy Site
- A minimum of 75 campers
- Housing and some meals for our staff
- A medical professional
- Follow up with families to continue spiritual impact



What Woodlands provides:

- A team of godly, college-aged staff that are highlytrained and background checked
- Unforgettable activities
- Impactful teaching
- High-energy programming and games
- Registration website
- Marketing materials
- A Freestyle Specialist to prepare you for your week of camp and execute at your site
- Leadership development program for high school students (LEAD)



What is Freestyle LEAD?

LEAD is our leadership development program for high school students. LEAD campers will...

- Have servant leadership opportunities
- Gain experience behind the scenes in a camp ministry setting
- Serve and grow alongside our Freestyle team
- Act as a booster for cabins
- Be poured into by our LEAD Counselors through daily sessions



Typical Daily Schedule:

7am: Staff arrival

8:30am: Check-in

9:00am: Quiet time with cabins

9:30am: Chapel

10:00am: Cabin devos

10:20am: Snack

10:45am: Game time 1

11:15am: Free time rotation 1

12:30pm: Lunch

1:00pm: Swords (Scripture memory)

1:45pm: Game time 2

2:15pm: Free time rotation 2

3:30pm: Closing rally

4:00pm: Check out

5:30-6pm: Staff departure



Volunteer Opportunities:

Host Homes: Our team needs a place to stay. Host families open up their homes for the week and provide beds, fellowship, and some meals.

Medical Professional: We require a medical professional on-site for safety reasons in case of medical needs. Preferably, this is a nurse, but can also be an EMT or another trained professional.

Monday Check-In Assistants: Help campers check in as they arrive at camp for the first time.

Other: We could always use help cleaning up, providing extra snacks for staff, or just being available. Let us know if you have extra volunteers who are eager to serve.



All About Host Homes

Synergy Sites are responsible for housing our team of about 20 staff. Most often, this looks like securing host homes.

- Minimum of 3 staff per host home
- Woodlands will provide transportation for staff in each home
- Staff will leave each morning between 5:45am6:30am depending on distance to the site
- Staff will return by 6:30pm
- Host homes are responsible for providing breakfast for staff each day as well as dinner most nights of the week
- Woodlands will notify each home of any allergies or staff dietary restrictions
