Psalm 22:1-5

READ





THINK

Jesus quotes part of this psalm as He is being crucified on the cross. He experienced being separated from God so that we can be reunited with Him. Have you put your trust in Him?

APPLY

This psalm mentions calling out to God. Whether you have big needs or small needs, ask God for His help today.

Psalm 23

READ





THINK

Sheep aren't known for being smart animals. They need a shepherd to help them thrive. The Lord is our shepherd! He is always watching over us and guiding us. What verse stands out to you in this passage?

APPLY

Read the chapter again and look for one verse to stand out. Pray that verse over your day today!

READ

Matthew 24:36-44





THINK

This is a prophecy and a promise. Jesus is telling His disciples how He plans to come back for us. We don't know when He will be back, so we must always be ready for His return.

APPLY

Are you ready for Jesus to return? Take some time to think back on the meaningful moments in your faith so far such as the day you got saved or the day you were baptized.

READ

Matthew 25:14-23





THINK

When you are given a responsibility, it's your job to do your best. It's your job to do a good job because others are counting on you.

APPLY

What responsibilities do you have in your house? What does it look like for you to do your best at those responsibilities?

READ

Matthew 26:47-56





THINK

Jesus knew this time was coming. When He saw Judas, He knew why he was there. Even though He knew it was coming. He could have stopped it. However, He let it happen. Why? For you! For all of us.

APPLY

How does it make you feel to know Jesus put you over Himself?

READ

Matthew 27:45-55





THINK

One of the most important parts of this passage is verse 50 where it says, "He gave up His spirit." No one took Jesus' life from Him. And He gave us His life for you!

APPLY

Jesus' entire ministry and life was a mission; a mission of redemption for you! Take a moment to think about what a gift it is that Jesus did all of this for you.

READ

Matthew 28:11-20





THINK

There are people in this world that will try to stop the spread of the name of Jesus. However, Jesus gives us a mission in this passage. This mission is to tell others about Him.

APPLY

Do you know any friends that don't know Jesus? Write down their names. Pray for them today. Then, the next time you see them, tell them about what you've learned from the book of Matthew.

READ





THINK

If God is really on our side, is there anything that I should fear?

APPLY

Write out anything that bothers you or scares you right now. In big letters, write over your problems with "THE LORD IS MY SALVATION," to remind you that He is on your side.

Psalm 30

READ





THINK

What would your life look like if you had God's favor?

APPLY

Put on your favorite worship playlist and spend some time praising God for who He is and what He's done.

Mark 1:16-20

READ





THINK

Jesus told these men they would "fish for people." Not only were they given something wonderful in following Jesus, but they were also going to learn how to "catch" people to join the same kingdom of God.

APPLY

Look at the names of your friends that don't know Jesus. This week, invite them to church!

Mark 2:1-12

READ





THINK

The paralyzed man had four friends that were dedicated to bringing their friend to Jesus. They were so determined that they created a hole in someone's roof to bring their friend closer to Jesus.

APPLY

What is keeping you from telling your friends about Jesus? Fear of not knowing what to say? Nervous they won't like you? Write down your fears. Pray and ask God that He will remove those fears and help you be brave.

Mark 3:13-19

READ





THINK

The men Jesus chose were not well known. They weren't really special. They were fishermen, a tax collector, a politician, and a treasurer. Common men that Jesus chose to follow Him and serve alongside Him.

APPLY

You don't have to be special to follow and serve Jesus. He just wants you to be all in and serve Him every day.

Mark 4:35-41

READ





THINK

Jesus starts by telling His disciples, "Let us go over to the other side." However, when a storm comes, they let their fear take over. They forgot what Jesus said. He said they were going to the other side. They didn't trust Him.

APPLY

We have been learning a lot about Jesus the past six weeks. Sometimes, however, we let fear make us forget what He promises us. Take a few minutes and look over your journal of what God has taught you. Never forget His promises!

Mark 5:1-13

READ





THINK

There are forces of evil in this world that only seek to do bad things. However, they are terrified of Jesus. They know He is more powerful. They are no match for Him.

APPLY

Knowing there are bad people in the world can be scary. However, if you're following Jesus, you don't need to be afraid. Joshua 1:9 says, "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

READ





THINK

Can you remember a time where you knew that God was working in your life?

APPLY

Take some time to write out some of the key moments in your life and how God was working in them.

READ





THINK

Sin affects us spiritually, physically, emotionally, and more! Are their any sins in your life that you need to talk to someone about?

APPLY

Spend time in prayer confessing your sins to God and asking for forgiveness.

Mark 6:39-46

READ





THINK

Jesus just got done doing a very BIG miracle. He fed thousands of people off of five fish and two loaves. Afterward, He went off on His own to pray.

APPLY

When do you feel like doing nothing else but praying? Write down the times that prayer is most important to you.

Mark 7:1-8

READ





THINK

Jesus quotes Isaiah here as he points out the most important thing: honoring Jesus with your heart. It's not about going to church, reading your bible, or singing worship songs. It's about following Jesus with all your heart.

APPLY

Are you following Jesus with all your heart? Be honest. How can you better follow Jesus?

Mark 8:1-9

READ





THINK

Jesus wanted to feed the people. So what did He do? He asked "How many loaves do you have?" The disciples were focused on what they didn't have. Jesus wanted whatever they had because He can do big things with anything.

APPLY

Jesus wants whatever you have so He can do great things with it. Write down your three biggest strengths or what you're good at. Then, look for ways to serve Jesus with those things.

Mark 9:14-24

READ





THINK

This man had a big problem. His son had been hurting for a long time. He didn't know what to do. What he learned here from Jesus is that all he needed to do was believe.

APPLY

Believing is hard to do. Especially when it's something really big. Do you need a miracle? Is there something big you need Jesus to do? Write it on a piece of paper, hold it in an open hand, and pray. Ask Jesus for something big and believe!

Mark 10:17-27

READ





THINK

Jesus was in the business of making impossible things possible. Salvation is only possible through Jesus.

APPLY

"All things are possible with God." Remember what we did yesterday? Do it again. Write what you need from Jesus on a piece of paper, hold it in an open hand, and pray. Ask Jesus for something big and believe!

READ





THINK

Have you ever experienced the Lord's goodness? What blessings have you seen from following God?

APPLY

Enjoy God through food today! Of course you can taste and see His goodness from anything, but eat your favorite snack or food today and remember how awesome God is!

Psalm 36:5-12

READ





THINK

The Lord's love is described using a lot of different pictures in theis passage. How would you describe His love?

APPLY

God's love for you is more than enough! Draw a heart on a small piece of paper and keep it with you today to remember God's love for you.

Mark 11:15-25

READ





THINK

A lack of faith is not the only obstacle to effective prayer. Refusing to forgive or holding on to bitterness can also block our prayers.

APPLY

Is there someone you need to forgive? Forgiving is hard. Sometimes people do some hurtful things to us. However, Jesus says we must forgive others. If there is someone you need to forgive, go do it today!

Mark 12:41-44

READ





THINK

Jesus shows us that before God, the spirit of giving determines the value of the gift more than the amount. God wants you to want to give generously. God loves the cheerful giver.

APPLY

Do you have a plan for giving to the Lord? If you do, great. Keep it up! If not, talk to your parents and make a plan on how you can give with a generous heart. No matter how much or how little. It's about your heart.

Mark 13:32-37

READ





THINK

An interesting thing about the Bible is that it gives us the end of the story before the story is over. Jesus will come back for us one day. When? We don't know. But we do know He will!

APPLY

What do you think it will be like when Jesus comes back for us? Draw a picture of what you think it will look like when Jesus returns.

Mark 14:32-42

READ





THINK

Why was Jesus troubled? Because He knew what was coming. He knew what was about to happen. He knew it was going to be hard. But hard is not bad. Hard is just hard.

APPLY

Is there something that you are ignoring because it's hard? Do you know it's something God wants you to do? Maybe it's forgiving someone. Maybe it's being kind to your brother or sister. Whatever it is, ask God to help you!

READ





THINK

In this passage, we are Barabbas. We were born sinners. We are the guilty ones. However, Jesus takes our place. He willingly stands in our place so we can be free.

APPLY

Jesus gave His life so that you could have it. How are you living your life for Jesus? Selfishly? Or are you living a life that shows how thankful you are that you are free because of Jesus?
