








Dear God: Will you help me learn one new thing from the Bible today? Thank you! Amen.

#### **THINK**

Jesus is our Savior and King. Take a minute to write down three things you can worship and thank Jesus for.









#### **THINK**

- 3. "I'm so glad you're my daughter / son"

Spend some time thanking God for His love. Examine your heart to see if there is any pride that is out of place.









#### **THINK**

Do you have enemies? Are people mean to you? Write down their name(s). Write down ways that you can show them love today!









#### **THINK**

Write down something in your life that is hard right now. Draw a castle around it to remind yourself that God is your place of safety even when things are difficult.











#### **THINK**

What are you worried about? Write each worry on a small piece of paper. Wad up each piece of paper and throw them into a trash can. Don't carry your worries. Get rid of them today!









Make a list of 1-3 people that you want to serve and how you will serve them.









If you haven't done so already, start a journal! Take the time to write down your takeaway from God's Word every day. This is how you can make sure His Word falls on "good ground."









Pray through verses 6 through 9. Is there anything specific that you need to ask for God's protection?









#### **THINK**

One of the greatest miracles recorded in Scripture. It's likely that a total of 15,000-20,000 people were served. God showed His great power through Jesus in feeding these people with just five loaves and two fish.

# **APPLY**

There are three takeaways from God's provision in this passage. Write these down right now:

- Thank God for and wisely use what you have
- Trust God's unlimited resources
- Don't waste what He gives you









#### **THINK**

Your words matter. What comes out of your mouth matters. Your words have the power to breathe life and death.

**APPLY** 

Don't let your words speak death. Speak life into other people. Talk to five different people and speak life into them by saying at least one encouraging thing about them.

#### THINK

It's likely that Peter wasn't aware he was speaking for Satan in this moment. This comes right after Jesus praises Peter. Peter was putting his wants and desires ahead of Jesus' mission of redemption for us!

**APPLY** 

Living in a close relationship with Jesus takes putting Jesus' wants and needs ahead of your own. It takes JOY. Jesus. Others. Yourself. Put Jesus and Others ahead of You! Find one way to practice JOY today.

READ

Matthew 17:14-20





#### **THINK**

It's not about how much faith we have, but about what that faith is in. A small amount of faith, as small as a mustard seed, can accomplish great things if that small amount of faith is placed in God and not self.

**APPLY** 

Is there any area in your life where you are struggling to have faith in God? If so, write it down. Talk to God about it. Have great faith in what He can do!

Matthew 18:15-20





#### **THINK**

If someone does something that hurts you, the best thing you can do is choose to love and forgive them. The worst thing you can do is talk to other people about it. If someone hurts you, talk to them, show love, and forgive like Jesus.

**APPLY** 

Is there someone in your life that has hurt you? Someone at school that hurt your feelings? Someone in your neighborhood who you're upset with? Talk to them today. Show love. Forgive!

#### **THINK**

God's way is perfect. That means he makes no mistakes. Have you ever felt like you were behind or didn't measure up? It's not true! God has a perfect plan for your life!

Spend some time today thanking God for the many talents and gifts that He has given you.









Take some time to reflect on Psalm 19:14. Consider writing it down and memorizing it!









Make a list of ways that you can put others ahead of yourself today. How many can you come up with?









#### **THINK**

Pride and greed say "I want more." A generous heart is grateful for whatever is given. The early workers forgot what they signed up for. They only focused on what others got and asked for more.

**APPLY** 

Did you start your journal to write down your takeaways each day? If you haven't, do it! If you have, add a new section to that journal. Each day, write down 1-3 things that you're thankful for.

Matthew 21:12-17





#### **THINK**

What they were doing wasn't right. So, Jesus did what was right. The right thing was to serve others. It's what God called Jesus and us to do. Even though it was hard.

**APPLY** 

You may have friends, classmates, neighbors, etc. that want you to do the wrong thing. When those times come, remember this passage. You don't have to flip over tables, but Jesus wants you to do the right thing even if it's hard!









### **THINK**

The same way we take care of ourselves and our own interests is how we should take care of and have concern for others interests. Look out for other people, not just yourself.

**APPLY** 

Jesus gives us the two greatest commandments in Matthew 22. If you forget everything else, remember these two commands: Love God and love others. Write this down and keep it somewhere you can see it often.
