READ





THINK

APPLY

Believing in Jesus is the only way of salvation and to receive the Holy Spirit. Our beliefs should be focused on what Jesus has done for us, not what others or ourselves have done. How can you make sure your beliefs are focused on Jesus?

READ





THINK

READ

READ





THINK

Paul shares his story of Jesus changing his life. Paul was broken and hated Christians, but Jesus loved him through it all and forgave Paul of his sin in Paul's time of repentance. Jesus the Redeemer is so evident in Paul's life.

APPLY

Our stories matter. We are all sinners in need of a savior. Jesus is that savior, and can change anyone's heart for Him. Has Jesus changed your life? If so, who can you share your story of salvation with?

Acts 23:12-21

READ





THINK

When those against Paul plotted to kill him, there was one person who could see that what they were doing was wrong. The young man spoke out against their plan and his warning to the commander saved Paul's life.

APPLY

While there may be many people who live sinfully, it is important as followers of Christ to stand against any disobedience towards God. Are you willing to stand up against the sinful actions of others to follow God's commandments?

Acts 24:5-14

READ





THINK

Not only did Paul know the truth, he lived it out. The way that his actions reflected his knowledge of the truth gave him confidence in what he spoke to Felix. Paul knew that he was right because he was following the Lord.

APPLY

If we live for Christ and obey Him, we can live with the confidence that we are living righteously. What are three things you can do to live for Christ today?

Acts 25:8-12

READ





THINK

Paul knew he was right and had not done anything wrong, which made it difficult for him to be punished. Paul stood up for his actions and beliefs. People wanted him dead, but he fought unrighteousness with righteousness.

APPLY

The unrighteousness of others should encourage us to remain righteous in our actions. The way we live should reflect Christ and make it difficult for anyone to speak poorly of us. How do your actions reflect Christ in your life?

Acts 26:24-31

READ





THINK

While Paul was making his case before King Agrippa, he explained his story and how the Lord changed him. Paul tells this story not only to prove his innocence, but more importantly, to share the gospel with King Agrippa.

APPLY

Paul had experienced the way Jesus changed his own life, and he wanted anyone who would hear him speak to experience the same heart change. Has Jesus changed your heart? If so, share your story with someone you know.

Acts 27:21-26

READ





THINK

Paul knew that his and his crewmates' lives were in God's hands, but the crew needed to be obedient to God during their time on the ship. God promised Paul that He would deliver them from danger and He fulfilled that promise.

APPLY

Although the situation was scary and dangerous, God was with them through all of it. The crew trusted what Paul said, and through their obedience, God saved them from death. How can you show trust in God in difficult or scary times?

Acts 28:23-31

READ





THINK

Salvation through faith in Jesus is for all people. Paul was trying to explain that it was for both the Jews and Gentiles. Although the people were rejecting Jesus, Paul remained faithful to teaching the gospel so that many would accept it.

APPLY

There will be people who reject the gospel, but it is important for us to remain faithful and have great endurance when it comes to telling others about Jesus. What are different ways you can constantly share the gospel with others?

READ





THINK

God had a plan in place all along for Jesus to die on the cross and rise again, defeating sin and death. This is good news and it means that we can have a relationship with Him by believing in Him!

APPLY

READ





THINK

READ

READ





THINK

APPLY

READ





THINK
