








Dear God: Will you help me learn one new thing from the Bible today? Thank you! Amen.

Be intentional to take some time to invite God into everything you do today, whether it's a big thing or a little thing.









Think about your weekly schedule. Are you prioritizing time with God each day? Do you attend a church each week? Is there a time that you could serve in a church or ministry? Make your life count!









Do you ever struggle to believe? What makes it hard to believe in Jesus?









Why do we doubt? What makes us doubt?









Our goal for you is that you would grow in wisdom and in favor with God and man. What does it look like to grow in wisdom? How do you do that?













What do you think a next step in your faith would be? Take some time to think about how you can keep growing in your walk with God.









What is hard in your life right now? Take some time to talk it over with God in prayer.













### **THINK**

The woman that Jesus was talking about wanted to show how thankful she was for Him. So, she showed Jesus a large amount of gratitude. Why? She wanted Jesus to know how important He is to her.

## **APPLY**

Unexpressed gratitude communicates ingratitude. When we don't say "thank you" for something someone does for us, it shows that we don't really care. Challenge: go to everyone in your family and thank them for something they have done for you.









### **THINK**

This is a small passage, but it says a lot. Jesus is telling us that His closest family are those who hear AND obey God's word. We grow closer to Jesus when we read His word and then do what it says.

APPLY

Take 5 minutes and look over your journal at the things you have been writing down from your quiet time. Have you been doing those things? This is a good reminder to do what Jesus tells us to do!









Do you want to be great? Start by being humble. What do you think it means to be humble? It means putting others first. Write down some ways you can put others ahead of yourself.









Set a timer and be still for 2 minutes. Try to only think about God.












One way you can give God praise is through song. Put on your favorite worship song or pick up an instrument and sing a song of praise!












See a need, do something about it.











Make a list five ways you can grow closer to God every day.









In life, we all need JOY. Jesus. Others. Yourself. Remember that. Focus on Jesus first. Then, others. Then, yourself.









List 10 things that you are thankful for today.









Do you serve money or God? Look at how you spend your money. Follow your money to find where your heart lies.









Do you take time to thank God and give Him glory for the things He does for you? Write down three big things you have seen God do for you. Take a few minutes and thank Him for those things.









How do you pray? Do you focus on other people seeing and hearing you? Or do you pray because you want to talk to your Heavenly Father?









When you do something wrong, what do you do? Do you try to get closer to Jesus?









Write down whatever problems come to your mind for 1 minute. Through prayer, give them over to God.









Do you fear people's opinions of you? Remember that what truly matters is that you are doing what God wants you to do, not just what people want you to do.








