








Dear God: Will you help me learn one new thing from the Bible today? Thank you! Amen.

When have you had to face something really hard? Something so hard that it made you really scared. Next time you face something like that, how can you be brave like Jesus?











Who are the leaders in your life? Spend some time thanking God for them and praying for them.









Staying close to God is so important. To help remember that He's always with you, write down verse 23 on a notecard and keep it with you all day.









How does it make you feel to know that Jesus will be coming back for us? How do you live your life differently knowing that?









Now that you have read through all of the Gospels, what did you learn from the stories and life of Jesus?









Followers of Jesus are called to share His love. What are some ways you can share the love of Jesus with others?









What are some ways you can turn away from your sin and towards God?









God blesses those who put their faith in Him. Those blessings can come in both expected and unexpected ways. Take a few minutes to write down five blessings God has given you.









God created everything in the universe including you! Thank God for how he made you.












There are so many miracles in the Bible. Maybe you've experienced a miracle in your life. Draw a picture of your favorite miracle.











God is our ultimate authority. Even in hard times, we are to obey God and do what he commands us to do. Think of some ways you can listen to God and obey Him.












Have you heard the story of your parent's faith? Ask someone older than you to share their story of coming to faith with you.













God forgives the sins of those who ask, and we can trust that he truly cleanses us from them. Have you asked God to forgive you of your sin?









We should always be willing to encourage other Christians to share the gospel. We should also be encouraged when we see others being faithful to God and His Word. What are some different ways you can encourage others around you?













Repentance can feel awkward but be reminded that God already knows everything. Spend some time telling God you are sorry for the wrong things that you have done.









Find a way to praise God today. Try something new!












God has a plan for all of us, and His plan will always outshine any hardships we will face. Think of three things that make following Jesus worth going through hard times for the sake of God's kingdom.











We are to always worship and glorify God. Our pure worship of God can be an example for others to follow. It could show someone how much they need Jesus. What are three different ways you can worship God?









How can you thank God for His creation by serving him today?












God's presence in our lives is comforting and should encourage us to live for Him in any situation. Think of some ways you can see the presence of God in your life and live in the comfort He brings.











